

# HPV: DON'T WAIT. VACCINATE!

## A PART 4 QUALITY IMPROVEMENT MOC PROJECT FOR INDIANA PEDIATRICIANS



### What is MOC?

Maintenance of Certification was designed by the American Board of Medical Specialties as a way to ensure a continuous cycle of lifelong learning for a physician's professional development.

### Who Can Participate in the HPV: Don't Wait. Vaccinate! Project?

This MOC, Part 4 Project has been approved by the American Board of Pediatrics for Indiana Pediatricians.

### What is a Part 4 Quality Improvement Project?

Part 4 is a diverse requirement which recognizes the efforts of pediatricians who imbed quality improvement into their day-to day practice of medicine. Pediatricians who complete this project will be awarded 25 Part 4 points toward their MOC.

### What is the Aim of this Project?

The HPV: Don't Wait. Vaccinate! Project is sponsored by the Indiana Immunization Coalition. Pediatricians who participate will aim to increase their 1st dose HPV vaccine rate for eligible females ages 11-21 by 25% during a 6 month period.

### What is the Completion Criteria for the Project?

Pediatricians will submit monthly data gleaned from a daily tracking log that indicates the number of females ages 11-21 who visited their office that month and the number who received an HPV vaccine.

### Is there a Cost for the Project?

There is no cost to participate in this MOC project. In addition, Pediatricians will be given educational materials at no cost to assist in their efforts.
